

## **RULES FOR ANYONE CHOOSING TO RIDE WITH CAPITAL BREWERY BIKE CLUB:**

1. HELMET REQUIRED
2. YOU MUST FOLLOW EVERY WISCONSIN TRAFFIC LAW AT ALL TIMES
3. ALL ROADS ARE OPEN TO TRAFFIC/CARS/TRUCKS. SOME ROADS HAVE MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVELING IN EXCESS OF 55 MPH AND HEAVY TRAFFIC. WITH INCREASES IN SPEED, THE CHANCE OF DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY INCREASES. GETTING HIT BY A CAR GOING 40MPH OR MORE IS ESTIMATED TO CAUSE DEATH 95% OF THE TIME.
4. ROUTES, MAPS, AND CUESHEETS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AND ERROR. USE YOUR OWN JUDGMENT WHEN DECIDING WHERE AND HOW TO RIDE. ROUTES, MAPS, AND CUESHEETS ARE MERELY A SUGGESTED ROUTE/ NOT MANDATORY OR REQUIRED.

5. RIDE WITH A PARTNER-NO ONE IS KEEPING TRACK OF YOU OR WHERE YOU ARE
6. BICYCLING ON ROADS CAN BE DANGEROUS AND DEADLY, IF YOU LACK EXPERIENCE RIDING ON ROADS, YOU SHOULD RIDE THE PATH CLOSED TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND TAKE A BICYCLE SAFETY CLASS BEFORE RIDING.
7. EACH RIDER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS/HER OWN ACTIONS.
8. ROUTES MAY CONTAIN KNOWN AND UNKNOWN DANGEROUS CONDITIONS LIKE GRAVEL, POTHOLES, GLASS, NARROW OR MISSING SHOULDERS, CARS PASSING AT HIGH SPEEDS, LOW VISIBILITY AND OTHER DANGERS. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR WATCHING FOR THESE CONDITIONS AND RIDING AT A SAFE SPEED IN A SAFE MANNER.
9. OTHER BICYCLISTS CAN CAUSE CRASHES THAT INJURE OR KILL YOU. RIDE NEAR PEOPLE YOU TRUST AND STAY AWAY FROM RIDERS YOU CONSIDER UNSAFE.

10. DO NOT EVER DRINK ALCOHOL BEFORE  
RIDING.
